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S&P Dow Jones Indices (S&P DJI) and the Mexican Stock Exchange (Bolsa Mexicana de Valores BMV) announce methodology changes to the BMV Indices

MEXICO, **May 25**, **2017**: S&P Dow Jones Indices (S&P DJI) and the Mexican Stock Exchange (BMV) today announced a change to the way total return indices are calculated. Effective on September 1, 2017, the new total return calculation will be as follows:

New Total Return Calculation:

The total return index calculation is derived from the price return index and daily total dividend returns. The first step is to calculate the total dividend paid on a given day and convert this figure into points of the price index:

$$TotalDailyDividend = \sum_{i} Dividend_{i} * Shares_{i}$$

Where Dividend is the dividend per share paid for stock i and Shares are the shares. This is done for each trading day. Dividend i is generally zero except for when a company has a dividend payment. Some stocks do not pay a dividend and Dividend is always zero. This is converted to index points by dividing by the divisor for the underlying price index:

$$IndexDividend = \frac{TotalDailyDividend}{Divisor}$$

The next step is to apply the usual definition of a total return from a financial instrument to the price return index.

$$Total\ Return = (\frac{P_t + D_t}{P_{t-1}}) - 1$$

and

$$DTR_{t} = (\frac{IndexLevel_{t} + IndexDividend_{t}}{IndexLevel_{t-1}} - 1)$$

P = Closing price per share on day t or t-1

D = Dividend per share on day t

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IndexLevel = Index level for the price return index on day t or t-1

where the Total Return and the Daily Total Return for the index (DTR) is stated as a decimal. The DTR is used to update the total return index from one day to the next:

Total Return Index_t = (Total Return Index_{t-1}) *
$$(1 + DTR_t)$$

For all total return intraday index calculations, an index dividend will be applied at the market open on the ex day to properly reflect the dividend adjustment.
